The Yarralumla Residents Association warmly welcomes the assurance by the Minister for Tourism, Mr Barr, that Weston Park Nursery will not be considered by the ACT Government as a potential permanent location for Floriade.

YRA President, Tony Hill, said: 'We are grateful that the Minister accepts and understands the concerns we raised about the enormous traffic problems such a proposal would create in the streets of Yarralumla, and its impact on the peaceful environment of Weston Park.

'We thank Mr Barr for the promptness with which he responded on this matter, and acknowledge that the ACT Tourism Ministerial Advisory Council will further examine Kingston Foreshore and Yarramundi Reach as possible Floriade sites.
